

Advantages for the employee

- **100 % Automatic** – It is much easier for the employee to keep his driver's log as all necessary data are recorded i.e. from where to where, the mileage, and purpose of the trip.
- **Don't cheat your self** – The system automatically remembers all the trips that are forgotten in the daily routine. Calculations show that it may amount to hundreds of miles on a yearly basis - and as such to hundreds of pounds.
- **Guarantee as to Inland Revenue** – Both Company and employee are guaranteed proper documentation towards the Inland Revenue. The system can document the requested information at any given time.
- **Avoid suspicion** – Employees avoid questions as to the validity of the miles entered. The vast majority of employees are decent and conscientious people, but are often confronted with a general mistrust to mileage reports. This problem is eliminated as all data are fully documented.
- **Save time every month** – Employees save hours of tedious work each month – hours that may be spent on for instance further sales efforts.

Why Autolog is NOT a Surveillance System

Avoid the confrontation with employees over surveillance

It is important to emphasize that Autolog is not a surveillance system, but a tool designed to save money for company and employees alike. Furthermore, both company and employees get a correct documentation for the Inland Revenue. Autolog is basically a tool which ensures that the whole process from registration of mileage to the settling of accounts for both customers and employees is automated.

Passive tracking

Autolog's GPS device registers the driving, but nothing is transmitted to the company until the user has downloaded the data to the computer and has compiled his driver's log. It is NOT possible to track the driving on-line.

Approved by the Data Supervising Authority in Denmark

The final driver's mileage report has been fully approved by the Data Supervising Authority in Denmark and contains no data that might be used by the employer against the employee.

Only dates – no hours or minutes registered in the driver's log

Inland Revenue does not require the registration of time in the driver's log, only dates and miles. Therefore the Autolog driver's mileage report only shows dates and miles but no hours for the recorded customer visits. This means that the individual company's representative (technician/salesperson/consultant) does not have to account for the exact hours of their customers visits.

Sensitive data are protected

Sensitive personal data do not appear in the log. Data included in the log are exclusively such data as the user himself indicates as being company related. This means, that it is the employee who decides what data will be available to the employer.

No difference between data in a manually compiled driver's log and Autolog.

In principle there is no difference between the data contained in the Autolog system and the information in a correctly compiled manual log. The data in the log are such as are required by Inland Revenue – no more and no less.
